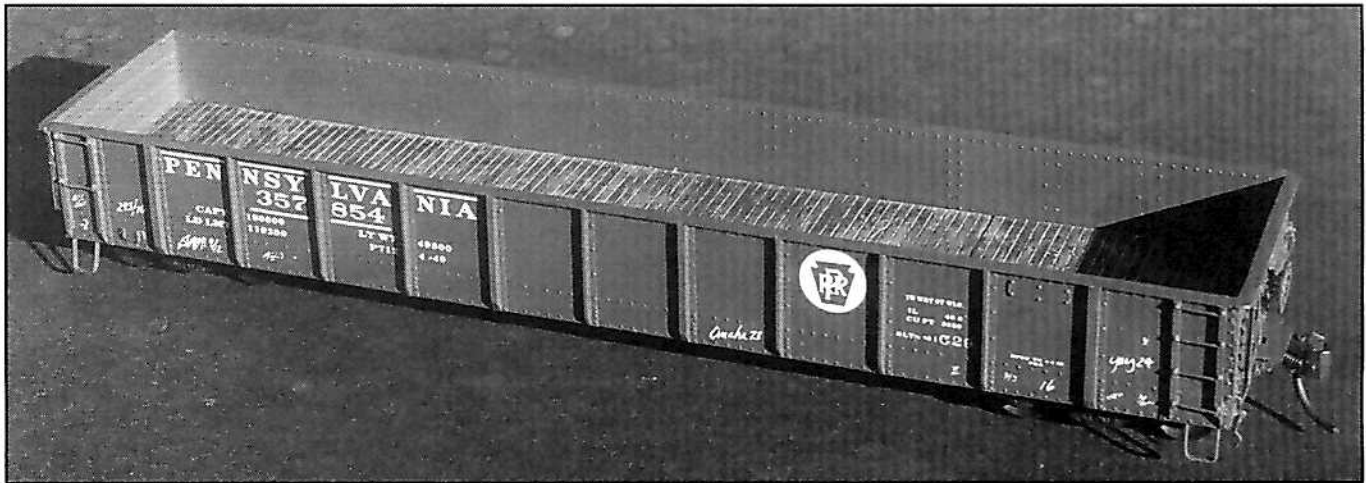
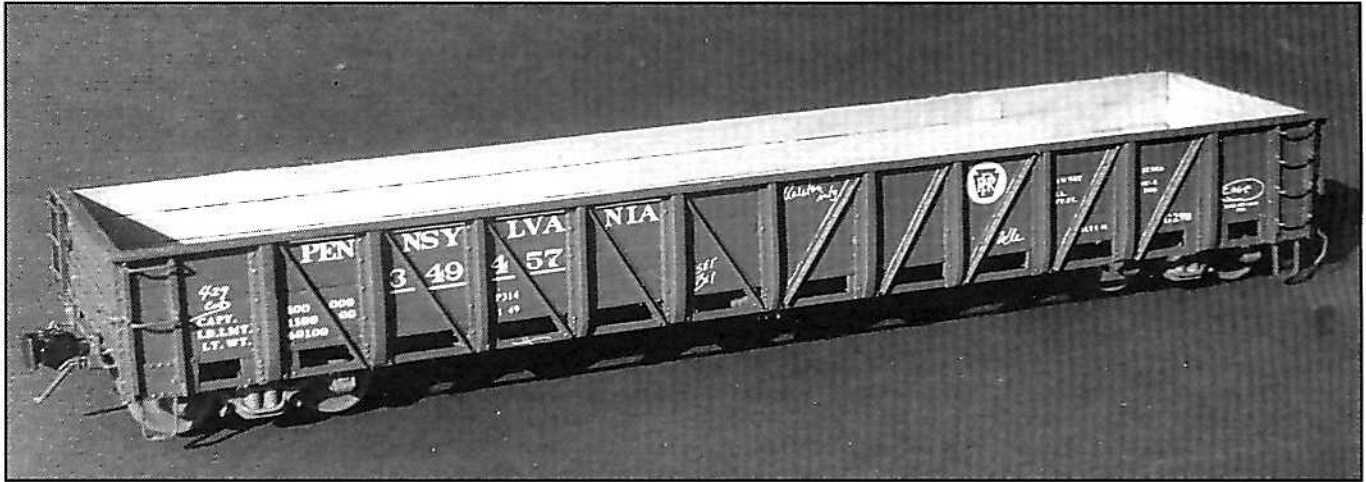

Revised and Improved in Quick-Kit Format Pennsy's G-29 and G-29 A&B 46' Gondolas



The Pennsy was known for going its own way and this was especially true for freight car design. In 1941, the road designed and built its own version of the then popular 46' gondola, the G-29. The demand for rolling stock was still unmet and the road received authorization to build more during 1942. This time the car had to be revised to a war emergency design. The steel sides were replaced by a steel truss and wood horizontal sheathing, becoming the G-29A&B.

Proprietary ends were stamped from such thin steel that an inside layer of wood sheathing was added.

The Sunshine kits of these Pennsy gons have been revised to the Quick-Kit format where sides and ends are cast together. Modern details have been added. The kits are vacuum cast in gray urethane. Kits include all detailing parts (except trucks and couplers) and decals for the circle keystone herald are included. A Prototype Data Sheet and instructions are included.
